## Chains

A juniper, 12 ins. diam., bears S.  $75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 43 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S1 BT.

## New bearing trees:

A juniper, 4 ins. diam., bears N.  $86\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 161 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  BT.

A juniper, 11 ins. diam., bears S.  $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 112 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  BT.

## Thence

N.  $0^{\circ}06'$  E., bet. secs. 1 and 6, (north half mile.)

28.00 Broad shallow draw, drains E.

32.00 Low sandy spur, slopes E.

40.27 Intersect the original cor. of Ts. 21 and 22 N., R. 19 E., which is a  
granite rock, 8x9x11 ins., mkd. 6 notches on S., E. and W. edges,  
firmly set in a small mound of embedded stones.

## At point for cor.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground,  
in a concrete mass, with the original corner stone deposited at the  
base, for cor. of Ts. 21 and 22 N., R. 19 E., with brass cap mkd.
