

Subdivision of Fractional T. 15 N., R. 21 E.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

T. 15 N., R. 21 E., M.D.M., is in the eastern end of Ormsby County, Nevada, 5 to 11 miles E. of Carson City and 3 to 9 miles S. of Dayton.

There is no permanent habitation within the township.

In 1953, strip mining of iron ore was being carried on in sec. 29. A good graded road from this mine joins Highway 50, about 4 miles east of Carson City. Fair dirt roads extend on through secs. 32 and 33 and into T. 14 N., R. 21 E. A combination of recently constructed and old dirt roads extend from the mine in sec. 29 to old mines in secs. 28 and on to a very old mine shaft near the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 22, locally known as "The Gallows" altho the head frame is now gone.

Eldorado Canyon, the boundary bet. Ormsby and Lyon Counties approximately follows the E. bdy. of the township. The old toll road along the canyon, connecting the mines of years ago in the Mineral Peak and Mt. Como area, with the smelter then located in Dayton is almost impassable, even to jeeps, above the old toll house just to the east of the E. bdy. of sec. 12.

The geographic position of the southeast corner of the township is latitude $39^{\circ} 06' 26''$ N., longitude $119^{\circ} 34' 08''$ W.
