

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF PORTION OF SUBDIVISION OF T. 17 N., R. 21 E.

Chains

N. 86° 52' W., bet. secs. 4 and 9, (West half mile.)

3.50 Small rocky spur, slopes N., desc. 50 ft. over W. slope.

8.40 Draw, drains N., asc. E. slope.

12.50 Spur, slopes N., desc. over broken N. slopes.

27.60 Small rocky spur, slopes N., desc. 40 ft. over W. slope.

41.66 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, very shallow coarse rocky, 3rd to 4th rate.

Timber, pinon pine, juniper.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush.

Grazing, fair to good.

N. 3° 33' E., bet. secs. 4 and 5,

Desc. 100 ft. over rocky NW. slope thru scattering timber and medium dense undergrowth.

8.40 Draw, drains NE., continue descent along broken NE. slope.

20.60 Small draw, drains N.55°E.

24.10 Small draw, drains N.70°E. 6 chs. to junction with draw from SE.

35.30 Main draw, drains N.30°W., asc. along rocky S. slope.

38.78 Proportionate distance; no trace was found of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

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from which,

A basalt boulder in a mass of rocks on the skyline, showing $\frac{1}{4} \times 3 \times 3$ ft. high, marked B0 x S4 on W. face, bears S. $84\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 235 lks. distant.

A pinon pine, $1\frac{1}{4}$ ins. diam., bears S. $49\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ W., 428 lks. dist., mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ S5 BT

Main draw draining N., bears West 160 lks. distant.

41.70 West tip of rocky spur from the SE., desc. 60 ft. over broken N. slope.

49.50 Recross main draw, drains N.20°E., continue along broken, rolling E. and NE. slopes.

72.60 Small draw, drains NE.

76.69 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp. at the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33 which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and wit. as described in the field notes of resurveys in T. 18 N., R. 21 E., executed under this same group.
