Chains

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original post alongside, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

40.10 The original cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, a juniper post, 2 ins. square at top, 30 ins. long, mkd. S1 on one face, R62E S12 on second face, and illegible scribe marks on the remaining faces, fallen on a mound of earth.

At point for corner

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a quartzite stone, $1\frac{1}{2} \times 4 \times 5$ ins., mkd. with a cross (X), deposited at base and the original post alongside, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd.

40.30 The original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., a juniper post, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. long, squared on two faces, marks weathered off.

At point for corner

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a granite stone, $4 \times 10 \times 14$ ins., mkd. with a cross (X), deposited at base, and the original post alongside, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
