T. 20 N., bet. Rs. 55 and 56 E.

Chains

Land, nearly level bed of Alkali Lake.
Soil, sandy clay, usually inundated by spring run-off.
No timber; undergrowth, none.

N. 0° 57' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over nearly level bed of Alkali Lake.

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1 only.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap mkd.

The standard cor. of Ts. 20 and 21 N., Rs. 55 and 56 E., monumented
with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as
described in the field notes of the survey and resurvey of portions
of T. 21 N., R. 55 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.

Land, nearly level Alkali Lake bed.
Soil, sandy clay, usually inundated by spring run-off.
No timber; undergrowth, none.

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the East Boundary of
Township 20 North, Range 54 East

Reestablishment of the south 2 miles as originally surveyed by
William T. Moran, Deputy Surveyor, in 1894, and of the remainder
as originally surveyed by John W. Fitzpatrick, Deputy Surveyor,
in 1905.

Beginning at the cor. of Ts. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 54 and 55 E.,
which is monumented with a limestone, 8x10x18 ins., set 12 ins.
in the ground, and marked with 6 notches on N., S., and W. edges,
with the E. edge markings chipped off. This cor. will now serve
for the SE. cor. of T. 20 N., R. 54 E. only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap mkd.
