

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of the East Bdy., T. 20 N., R. 54 E.

Chains

Deposit the old corner stone at base of the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy, gravel and rocky.

Timber, a few scattering mahogany; undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush, chokecherry, and a good growth of grass.

N. 0° 04' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 13.

Over mountainous land, through dense undergrowth; desc. 80 ft. over N. slope.

4.40 Ravine, course N. 60° W.; asc. 15 ft.

12.00 Top of spur, slopes N. 50° W.; desc. 100 ft.

19.10 Shallow wash, course W.; asc. 10 ft.

21.90 Saddle on top of ridge; ridge bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.; desc. 170 ft. over N. slope.

31.30 Old road, bears NW. and SE.

33.60 Ravine, with a small stream, 2 lks. wide, 2 ins. deep, course N. 60° W.; asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.

40.25 The original ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 18, which is monumented with a granite stone, 6x7x8 ins. showing above ground, firmly set, mkd. ¼ on W. face, with slight traces of pits. This cor. is now remonumented to refer to sec. 13 only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
