

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of the Subdivision, T. 17 N., R. 19 E.

Chains

78.18

The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the N. bdy. of the township, which is monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record of the resurvey of T. 18 N., R. 19 E., executed under Group 332, Nevada.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, very coarse rocky loam.

Undergrowth, manzanita, buckbrush and willow.

Timber, yellow pine, mahogany, fir and aspen.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp. N. $0^{\circ} 14'$ E., bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Over rough mountainous land, through heavy timber and scattering undergrowth; desc. 280 ft. over steep N. slope.

Small watercourse, drains E.; asc. 20 ft. over gentle SE. slope.

13.50

Spur, projects N. 60° E.; desc. 380 ft. over broken NE. slope to creek.

31.90

Old timber-drag or wood road, bears E. and W.

34.40

Trail in old wood road, bears E. and W. From this point, an old log cabin bears N. 80° E., 1 chain dist.

36.20

Creek, 8 lks. wide, 2 ins. deep, course N. 70° E. from SW.

36.70

Old wooden flume, bears E. and W.

38.00

Small gravel rise between streams, projects E.

40.00

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, at record distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

This point falls in bottom of small dry watercourse draining E. where it is impracticable to establish monument.

40.25

Point for the witness $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, on rocky SE. slope, in safe place for the corner monument.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A limber pine, 18 ins. diam., bears S. $60 \frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 110 lks. dist., mkd. WC $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 BT.

A red fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. $55 \frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 89 lks. dist., mkd. WC $\frac{1}{4}$ S32 BT.

Small rocky point, projects E.; desc. 40 ft. over abrupt NE. slope.

43.20

Ophir Creek, 12 lks. wide, 5 ins. deep, course E. about 25 chs. to Price's Lake.

Asc. abrupt SE. slope, 480 ft. to the 58.80 ch. point.
