

Dependent Resurvey of the Nevada-Utah State Line

Chains.	
10.40	The closing corner of Tps. 1 N. and 1 S., R. 19 W., of the Salt Lake Meridian, Utah, bears East, 2 links dist., monumented by a limestone, 19x16x10 ins. above ground partially supported on the N. side by a mound of stone, mkd. CCU on the E., 6 grooves on the N., S., and E. faces, and witnessed by a mound of stone 2½ ft. base, 1 ft. high to the E. This corner is 8 lks. dist. W. of the edge of the cliff.
11.50	Begin ascent of 90 ft. over a rocky N. slope.
12.40	Top of rugged rocky spur, slopes precipitously NE.; desc. 107 ft. over a rocky SE. slope.
16.90	Ravine, course NE.; asc. 454 ft. over a series of broken ledges on a N. slope.
34.00	Spur, slopes S. 80° E. from round topped peak approximately 2 chs. dist to the W.; desc. 172 ft. over a S. slope.
41.15	Ravine, course S. 75° E.; asc. 61 ft. over a N. slope.
44.10	Ridge, bears N. 70° W. and S. 65° E.; desc. over a precipitous S. slope 328 ft.
52.50	Hillside ravine, course SW.; asc. 35 ft. over NW. slope.
53.40	Spur, slopes SW.; thence along rough W. slope.
54.40	Hillside drain, course SW.
55.45	Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 120 ft. along rough SW. slope.
58.60	Hillside ravine, course SW.; continue descent.
59.70	Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 188 ft. over a S. to SW. slope.
65.10	Ravine, course SW.; asc. 16 ft. over a N. slope.
67.70	Spur, slopes W.; desc. 93 ft. over a S. slope.
70.15	Bottom of main canyon, course S. 20° E.; asc. 15 ft.
71.70	Point of spur, slopes SE.; desc. 67 ft. over a S. slope.
74.70	Enter main canyon, course S. from N. 30° E.; desc. 30 ft. along bottom of canyon.
76.90	Leave canyon, course S. 20° E.; asc. 15 ft. over N. slope.
78.40	Point of rocky spur, slopes SE.; desc. 36 ft. over S. slope.
79.88	Mile post No. 39, monumented with a limestone, 10x10x12 ins. above ground, mkd. U on the E., N on the W., and 39M on the S. faces, and witnessed by a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1½ ft. high to the S.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground and in a flat mound of stone 6 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
