East, bet. secs. 3 and 10.

Asc. 90 ft. over precipitous NW. slope.

1.90 Spur, slopes SW.; asc. 200 ft. over W. slope of mountain.

11.60 Hillside ravine near head, course SW.; asc. 173 ft.

16.83 Ridge, bears N. and S. An aircraft beacon light bears S. 0° 15' E. Desc. 42 ft.

18.50 Ravine near head, course S. to SE.; asc. 42 ft.

21.20 Spur, slopes SE.

21.70 Top of cliff, 40 ft. high ; desc. 394 ft. over abrupt precipitous E. slope of mountain.

33.10 Head of ravine, course S. 10° W.; asc. 20 ft. over a W. slope.

37.42 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 52 ft. along a N. slope.

40.00 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 10.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
