

Dependent Resurvey of the East Boundary of T. 21 S., R. 62 E.

Chains


Land, rolling and broken.
 Soil, sand, gravel, and rock, 4th rate.
 No timber.
 Undergrowth, mesquite, greasewood, shadscale, rabbit and burro brush.
 Poor grazing land.

N. 3° 30' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over broken mountainous land, through short undergrowth; gradually descend.

- 0.50 Wash, drains W.
- 2.60 Spur, projects W.
- 4.90 Wash, drains N. 85° W.
- 8.50 Ridge of spur, bears N. 80° W.
- 10.40 Wash, drains S. 85° W., 100 ft. below sec. cor.
- 13.10 Junction of washes from NE. and SE., drains W.; gradually ascend.
- 17.80 Enter wash, drains S. 20° W.
- 26.50 Leave wash, drains S. 20° W.
- 30.50 Enter wash, drains S. 10° W.
- 36.60 Leave wash, drains S. 10° W.
- 41.51 Proportionate point.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



raise a mound of stone, 2 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

- 44.30 Road in wash, bears N. 15° E. and S. 15° W.; wash drains S. 15° W.
 - 55.80 Wash, drains E.
 - 57.40 Small spur, projects E.
 - 61.50 Wash, drains E.
 - 70.30 Small spur, projects E.
 - 71.30 Small wash, drains E.
 - 74.40 Small spur, projects E., 110 ft. above 1/4 sec. cor.; descend 110 ft. to closing cor.
 - 78.60 Small spur, projects E.
 - 81.20 Wash, drains E.
 - 81.79 Intersect the Fifth Standard Parallel South, S. 89° 31' W., 14.49 chs. dist. from the stan. cor. of Tps. 20 S., Rs. 62 and 63 E.
