Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of Tps. 21 S., Rs. 62 and 63 E., with brass cap mkd.

12.60 Road along telephone line, bears N. 56° W. and S. 56° E.

14.00 Telephone line, bears N. 56° W. and S. 56° E.

14.30 Road, bears NE. and SW.

15.30 Road, bears NE. and SW.

16.00 Road, bears NE. and SW.

40.35 Telephone line, bears N. and S.

40.73 Proportionate point.
