	From the closing cor., the stan. cor. of secs. 34 and 35 bears S. 88° 00' E., 15.07 chs. dist.																								
	Land, very broken and rolling mountains, with spur and washes extend- ing westerly about 30 chs. to valley. Soil, sand and gravel with alkali and gypsum, rocky surface, 4th rate. Timber, thickets of mesquite about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to W. of line. Undergrowth, chaparral, sagebrush, shadscale, burro brush, catclaw, cactus, and scant grass. Poor grazing land.																								
	From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., N. 0° 05' E., bet. secs. 33 and 34.																								
	Descend gradual N. slope of rolling land, through short undergrowth.																								
14.40	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains NE. for 5 chs., thence N. 20° E. to main wash.																								
28.15	Electric power line, bears S. 52° 50' E. and N. 52° 50' W.																								
28.90	Service road to power line, bears same.																								
30.90	Bank of wash, 8 ft. high, bears NE. and SW.; thence across wash.																								
33.30	Graded road in wash, from Witney to gravel pit, bears N. 50° E. and S. 25° W.; wash drains N. 50° E.
