deposit a lava stone, 3x4x10 ins., mkd. with a cross (+) at base of post.


43.84 Industrial fence, woven and barbed wire 7 ft. high, enclosing plant of Basic Magnesium Inc., bears N. 81° 11' E. and S. 81° 11' W. for 68 lks. to angle point, thence N. 58° 49' W.

Thence through main industrial plant area.

80.64 The original cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, and 14. The original cor. monument was recently destroyed during construction work of the Basic Magnesium plant; the cor. point was recovered through ties furnished by the Union Pacific Railroad.

At cor. point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 42 ins. in the ground, with a lava stone, 3x5x9 ins., mkd. with a cross (+) deposited at base, for cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, and 14, with brass cap mkd.

The outside of SE. corner of concrete inset for outside pumps for boiler house, bears S. 1½° E., 214 lks. dist.

The outside of SW. corner of concrete inset for the above pumps, bears S. 9½° W., 222 lks. dist.

The NW. corner of boiler house, bears S. 55½° E., 291 lks. dist. (building No. W-15).

Land, slightly rolling.

Soil, gravelly and stony, 3d to 4th rates.


Undergrowth, creosote.

Grazing, poor.

The original cor. of secs. 12 and 13, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., which was remonumented in 1931 with an iron post, falls within the industrial plant area of Basic Magnesium Inc., and the monument has recently been destroyed. The corner point is recovered through ties furnished by the B.M.I. engineers and verified by me in retracements to N., S., and E.

At cor. point, 0.2 ft. W. of the W. side of storm drain catch basin and 2.55 ft. southerly from the NW. cor., and 1.3 ft. northwesterly from the SW. cor. of same,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 44 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 12 and 13, with brass cap mkd.

Concrete monument with coordinates 100+80 N., 196+10 E., set at intersection of centerline railroad spur with 14th street (between units 9 and 10), bears N. 21½° W., 55.3 lks. (36.5 ft.) dist.
