80.00

Point for the standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, at record distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Land, gently rolling.

Soil, sandy clay adobe.

No timber; undergrowth, shadscale and greasewood.

West, on the S. bdy. of sec. 34, along the Sixth Standard Parallel North.

Over gently rolling land, through low undergrowth.

Dry wash, 5 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains S. 15° E.; asc. gradual SE. slope.

Flat spur, slopes S.; desc. gradual SW. slope.

27.50

Dry wash, 8 lks. wide, 8 ft. deep, course S. 60° E.; asc. over gradual E. slope.

Point for the standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 34, at record distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

A ranch house, bears S. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 222.20 chs. dist.

State road No. 48, graded, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.

E. foot of rugged mountain range, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.; asc. over boulder-strewn E. slope.

Point for the standard cor. of secs. 33 and 34, at record distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

The calculated position for the SW. cor. of T. 31 N., R. 24 E., bears West, 264.80 chs. dist.

From this calculated position for the SW. cor. of T. 31 N., R. 24 E., the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, Ts. 31 N., Rs. 23 and 24 E., which is monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears North, 343.07 chs. dist. (Calculated).
