Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, with a limestone, 3x4x5 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
