

Completion of the subdivision of T. 42 N., R. 25 E., M.D.M.

Chains	N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 4 and 5. Asc. 100 ft. over S. slope.
16.50	Ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 200 ft. over general N. slope.
38.50	Drain, course NE. curving to N.; over rolling mountainous land draining generally N.
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to underlying rock, with a sandstone, 3x5x8 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd. $\begin{array}{r} \frac{1}{4} \\ S5 \mid S4 \\ 1946 \end{array}$ Desc. 90 ft. over rolling mountainous land draining generally N.

80.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of lots 1 and 8, sec. 5 and of lots 4 and 5, sec. 4, with brass cap mkd. $\begin{array}{r} S5 \mid \begin{array}{c} 1 \mid 4 \\ 8 \mid 5 \end{array} \mid S4 \\ 1946 \end{array}$ raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
98.56	Desc. 60 ft. over rolling mountainous land draining generally N. Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 43 N., R. 25 E. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., over a cross (X) mkd. on surface rock, in a mound of stone 6 ft. base, 3 ft. high, for closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap mkd. $\begin{array}{r} T43N \\ S32 \\ \hline S5 \mid S4 \\ T42N \mid R25E \\ CC \\ 1946 \end{array}$ This closing sec. cor. is located 1.70 chs. west of a graded road, bears N. and curves to SE. From point of intersection, the cor. of secs. 32 and 33, T. 43 N., R. 25 E., bears East, 9.60 chs. dist.; an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record. From the same point, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 32, T. 43 N., R. 25 E., bears West, 30.40 chs. dist.; an iron post, 1 in. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record. Land, rolling mountainous. Soil, gravelly and rocky, 3rd and 4th rate. Timber, none. Undergrowth, sagebrush. Grazing, fairly good.
