through Range 53 East.

Chains

Reset the original post alongside the iron post and raise a flat mound of stone, 3 ft. diam., around the post.

Land, level.
Soil, clay.
Undergrowth, shadscale.

Dependent Resurvey of the West Bdy. of T. 21 S., R. 54 E.

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by Brunt and
Proctor, Deputy Surveyors, in 1881.

From the cor. of Ts. 21-22 S., Rs. 53-54 E. marked by an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the 1934 resurvey record. Add marks 1948.

N. 0° 49' W., bet. secs. 36 and 31.

Over level desert land thru low shadscale.

30.00 Shallow drain, 5 lks. wide, course S. 75° W.

35.00 Shallow drainage area, 40 lks. wide, course SW.

40.00 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Bury a granite stone, 4x6x8 ins., mkd. X, alongside the iron post, dig pits 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.

54.40 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course W.; asc. 40 ft. over a gradual S. slope.

75.00 Enter scattered mesquite bears E. and W.

80.00 Point for the corner of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, at proportionate dist.; no evidence remains of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
