Chains	<p>This cor. is situated on the W. edge of the road.</p> <p>Land, level. Soil, clay. Timber, mesquite. Undergrowth, shadscale.</p>
	<p>N. 3° 05' W., along the W. bdy. of sec. 6.</p> <p>Through low shadscale along W. edge of N. and S. road.</p>
3.60	Road bears NW. and S.
4.20	Waste ditch, dry, 5 lks. wide, 1½ ft. deep, course NW.
5.40	Old waste ditch, dry, with mesquite lined banks, NW. Continue over open flat.
12.00	Shallow drain, course W.
25.20	Dirt road, fair condition, bears N. 80° W.
38.61	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, 40 chs. in latitude from the cor. of secs. 1 and 12.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>¼ S 1</div><div>1948</div></div> <p>from which</p> <p>Drilled well, 10 inch steel casing, 24½ ft. to water, bears S. 81° 45' W., 3.22 chs. dist.</p> <p>Bury a stone, 4x6x7 ins. mkd. X alongside iron post and raise small flat mound of stone around post.</p>
39.21	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate dist. No evidence remains of the original mound and pits. A mesquite post 2 ins. diam., 4 ft. long, mkd. ¼, lying loose; bears E. ¼ lks. dist. This cor. is changed to a ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 6 only.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>¼ S 6</div><div>1948</div></div> <p>Bury a stone 4x5x6 ins., mkd. X and reset the orig. post alongside the iron post.</p>

65.80	Wash, 10 lks. wide, course SW.
78.79	The original closing cor. of Ts. 21 S., Rs. 53-54 E., monumented with a brass tablet seated in the top of a concrete post 13 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, with a squared mesquite post illegibly scribed, 3 ins. diam., 16 ins. above ground; and a juniper post 8 ins. diam., 4 ft. above ground set alongside. This cor. was remonumented in 1926 by the GLO in cooperation with the
