## Chains

Reestablishment of the survey executed by Guy Redwine,  
U. S. Surveyor and Dupree R. Averill, U.S. Transitman,  
in 1917.

Resurvey commenced at the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, T. 24 N., R. 8 E.,  
S.B.M. which is marked by an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set,  
and marked and witnessed as described in the record of the 1933  
resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 24 N., R. 9 E., S.B.M.

Thence

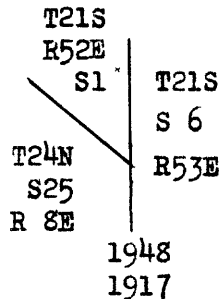
N. 0° 21' E., along E. bdy. of sec. 25.

Over level land.

27.60

The closing cor. of T. 24 N., R. 8 E., S.B.M., on the Von Schmidt  
State Boundary line, marked by an iron post, 3 ins. diam., 10 ins.  
above ground, marked and witnessed as described in the 1933 record  
of the resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 24 N., R. 8 E., S.B.M.

As this corner now refers to T. 21 S., Rs. 52 and 53 E., M.D.M.,  
the marks on the brass cap are changed to read:



Land, level.  
Soil, sandy and gravelly.  
Undergrowth, shadscale.

Survey of the boundary bet. T. 21 S., Rs. 52 and 53 E.

From the cor. of T. 24 N., R. 8 E., S.B.M., and T. 21 S., R. 52 E.,  
M.D.M., on the Von Schmidt State Boundary

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Through scattered mesquite over a wide drainage area cut by many  
small drains, course W.

Enter dense mesquite, bears E. and W.

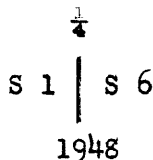

Leave mesquite, bears NE. and SW.; enter open flat.

Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, 40.00 chains in latitude  
from the closing corner of secs. 6 and 7, T. 21 S., R. 53 E., M.D.M.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground,  
with brass cap mkd.



dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.
