General Description

This area embraced in this survey is nearly level desert land situated in the center of the Pahrump Valley, and in the SE. cor. of Nye County, Nevada, with a general drainage to the WSW. The mean elevation above sea level is 2600 ft.

Access to the area is by unimproved roads in poor condition, four radiating from the Manse Ranch located $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles E. of the NE. cor.; one southeasterly from the Pahrump Ranch three miles to the NE. cor. then S. along the E. bdy. for four miles; and by a winding road from the Shoshone, California - Pahrump, Nevada road at a point 6 miles W. of the Pahrump Ranch southeasterly through the center of the area.
