

## T. 22 S., R. 53 E., M.D.M.

T. 22 S., R. 53 E., M.D.M. is located in Pahrump Valley near the extreme southeast corner of Nye County, Nevada and adjacent to the California-Nevada state boundary.

The east boundary of the township, being the west boundary of T. 22 S., R. 54 E., was resurveyed under the direction of the General Land Office in 1934 as represented on the plat of T. 22 S., R. 54 E., M.D.M. approved April 23, 1935. The present California-Nevada state boundary was surveyed by the United States Coast and Geodetic Survey in 1893 to 1899 and was resurveyed and Mile Posts established between the state line monuments in connection with surveys in California adjacent to the state line executed under the direction of the General Land Office in 1933, as represented on the plat of T. 22 N., R. 9 E., S.B.M. approved April 30, 1935.

The following field notes are those of the amendment of the resurvey of the boundary of T. 22 S., R. 54 E., altering the corner markings to refer to T. 22 S., R. 53 E. and subdivision of T. 22 S., R. 53 E., including the establishment of  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cors. of minimum control on the California-Nevada state boundary.

Refer to the field notes of T. 21 S., R. 53 E., M.D.M., Nevada executed under this same assignment concerning work preliminary to the dependent resurvey, method of measurements, instruments used and method of projection of lines and determination of azimuths.

Amendment of the resurvey as executed by Roger F. Wilson in 1934 in which the corners along this line were marked as corners of minimum control referring to the sections of T. 22 S., R. 54 E., only. The function of these corners is changed to corners of maximum control and the following alterations are made in the corner monuments.

The cor. of lots 13 and 14 of sec. 6 only, is marked by an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set marked and witnessed as described in the official record. The cor. is changed to a lot cor. of secs. 1 and 6.

Change the markings on the brass cap to read:

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 6 only is marked by an iron post, 1 inch diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record. The cor. is changed to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6.

Change the markings on the brass cap to read:

The cor. of secs. 6 and 7 only is marked by an iron post 2 ins. diam. firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.
