From this cor. Mon. No. Ill on the California-Nevada state line bears S. 46° 19' E., 6.93 chs. dist. and is monumented by a redwood post, 4x4 ins. 18 inx. above a mound of earth 8 ft. diam., 1 ft. high, firmly set, marked with small nails, N. on the NE., C on the SW., and Ill on the NW. faces, and witnessed by a limestone 8x10x16 ins. mkd. with a drill hole in the top, alongside the SE. face 6 ins. below surface of the mound.
