40.87 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6; at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The township is located about four miles east of Gabbs, Nevada on the western slope of the Paradise Mountains.

The soil varies from a sandy loam in the valley to clay and exposed granite on the mountainous areas. There is no timber of commercial value. There is no permanent water supply in the area.

An active iron mine is located in Section 21 near the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 21. There are numerous abandoned mines throughout the township.

There are no settlers in the area.
