Retracement of the East Boundary of T. 40,N., R. 39 E.,
Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada

Re-establishment of a portion of the survey
executed by William Epler, Deputy Surveyor,
in 1867

The cor. of Tps. 39 and 40 N., Rs. 39 and 40 E., monu-
mented with a stone, 24x8x8 ins., plainly mkd. with 6
notches on N., E., S., and W. faces.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground with brass cap mkd.

Bury the original cornerstone alongside the iron post
and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S.
of cor.

N. 0° 05' E., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

- 28.00 Trail road, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.
- 28.20 Fence, 5-strand barb-wire, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.
- 40.255 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36; there is
no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Corner not remonumented.
- 44.96 Well, bears W., 2.27 chs. dist.
- 48.20 Fence, 6-strand barb-wire, bears S. 70° E. and N. 70° W;
leave desert undergrowth, enter cultivated field, bears
same.
- 49.00 REA powerline, bears NE. and SW.
- 80.51 Point for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, at pro-
portionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of
the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 28 ins.
in the ground with brass cap mkd.
