64.80 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SW.

79.47 Intersect the Eighth Standard Parallel North.

Point for the closing cor. of T. 40 N., Rs. 39 and 40 E. at proportionate distance, based on the original plat and on E. and W. fence line; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.
