T. 41N., R. 39 E., Mount Diablo Meridan, Nevada

Re-establishment of the survey executed by William Epler, Deputy Surveyor, in 1867.

Point for the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on the N. bdy. of the Tp., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Set a wood post, 5 ft. long, 4 ins. diam., 3 ft. in the ground W. of the iron post.

From this corner the cor. of Tps., 41 and 42 N., Rs. 39 and 40 E., monumented with a steel rod, 1x4 ins. wide, 6 ft. long, buried 3 ft. in the ground at cor. of fences, bearing S. and W., bears N. 89° 35' E., 161.16 chs. dist. This position has long been recognized as the cor. by adjacent land owners.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
