CHAINS

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.
Asc. 130 ft. over E. slope.

48.00 Spur, bears S.; continue over rolling land.

48.50 Trail road, bears NW. and SE.

63.30 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S. 30° E.

71.60 Ravine, drains S. 10° E.

73.90 Trail road, bears S. 10° E. and N. 10° W.

80.00 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, in fence, bearing N. and S., monumented with a trapstone, 18 x 10 x 4 ins. firmly set in a mound of stone and plainly mkd. with 4 notches on the E. face and 2 notches on the W. face.

At the corner point.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base to cap, with brass cap mkd.

Reestablishment of the surveys executed by Palmer in 1868 and Horton in 1908.

The cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, and 14, as determined by the cor. of fence bearing E., W., and irregular S.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

22.90 Mullinix Creek, 50 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains SW.
