GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land surveyed within this township varies from gently rolling desert land to rolling mountainous land and is located in the upper part of Paradise Valley. The soil is sandy clay and rocky. The area drains southeast into the valley. The only timber is aspen along Solid Silver Creek.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by State Highway 8B, which bears Northerly through the township and other improved and trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during this survey.
