

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY, E. BDY., T. 44 N., R. 41 E.

## CHAINS

- 54.50 Rocky ridge, bears SE. and NW.; desc. 130 ft. over N. slope.
- 64.80 Creek, 20 lks. wide, 6 ft. deep, course W.; asc. 70 ft. over SE. slope.
- 80.28 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4½ ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
