From the cor. of Tps. 43 and 44 N., Rs. 41 and 42 E.
N. 87° 50' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth; asc. 90 ft.
over E. slope.

25.30 Ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 60 ft. over SW. slope.

31.70 Ravine, drains S.; asc. 40 ft. over SE. slope.

34.60 Spur, bears S.; desc. 120 ft. over W. slope.

40.98 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
