

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 44 North, Range 41 East, ranges from about 5300 to 7300 ft. above sea level and is rolling to mountainous. The soil is sandy clay loam and rocky. There is a light stand of willows and aspen along the drainages. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, budsage and sparce native grasses.

The township is drained by the North Fork Little Humboldt River which crosses through the northeast portion of the township and Martin Creek which crosses the southwest portion of the township. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by desert roads. There are no settlements within the township.
