	<p>Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by U. S. Deputy Surveyors A. J. Hatch and J. H. Eaton, in 1870, and Resurveyed by U. S. Deputy Surveyor H. B. Maxson, in 1900.</p>
	<p>The standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, monumented with a limestone, 12x10x6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. face and SC on the S. face.</p> <p>Corner not remonumented.</p> <p>N. 89° 25' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 36.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth; along a fence.</p>
37.61	<p>Point for the closing corner of secs. 1 and 2, T. 40 N., R. 54 E., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Point not monumented.</p>
40.73	<p>The standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a limestone, 10x10x8 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone and mkd. with 1 notch on the E. edge, 5 notches on the W. edge and SC on the N. face.</p> <p>Corner not remonumented.</p> <p>Corner is located at corner of fences, bearing N., S. and E.</p>
	<p>N. 89° 39' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 35.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth.</p>
11.40	Bladed road, bears NW. and SE.
14.60	Enter meadow, bears NW. and SE.
23.80	Ditch, drains SE.
40.41	<p>Point for the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Point not monumented.</p>
50.10	Foreman Creek, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course SE.
77.87	<p>Point for the closing corner of secs. 2 and 3, T. 40 N., R. 54 E., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p>
