This tract was located by the subdivision of sec. 9, as surveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor H.B. Maxson, in the usual manner. The field notes of the boundaries of Tract No. 40 only are furnished herewith.

Point for AP 1, Tract No. 40, identical with the W. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, as surveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor H.B. Maxson.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
