Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
U. S. Deputy Surveyors A. J. Hatch and J. H. Eaton,
in 1870.

The cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30 on the E. bdy. of the
Tp., monumented with a wooden post, 2 ins. square, pro-
jecting 20 ins. above ground and mkd. with 2 grooves on
the S. face, 4 grooves on the N. face and firmly set in a
mound of earth.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in
the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
