## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The portion of the township resurveyed varies from rolling to level meadow land. The soil is mostly a clay mixed with gravel on the uplands and a sandy silt along the creeks.

The vegetation consists of sagebrush on the uplands and meadow grasses along the creeks. A considerable portion of the uplands has been reseeded with crested wheat grass.

Mahala, Gance and McClellan Creeks drain southeasterly into the North Fork of the Humboldt River.

There is no timber; cattlemen are the principal users of the area.

No mineral formations were noted during the course of the resurvey.
