Soil, clay and gravel. Undergrowth, sagebrush and bunchgrass.</p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land varies from rocky hills to level valleys. The soil consists of a clay loam on the upland and a sandy silt along the creek bottoms.</p> <p>The water is supplied by Foreman Creek and the North Fork of the Humboldt River which flows through the township in a southerly direction.</p> <p>The principal uses of the township is grazing for cattle on the uplands and the raising of native hay along the streams.</p> <p>The Haystack Ranch is located in section 21. The Rancho Grande Ranch is located in section 5.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
