R. 55 E., bears S.  $89^{\circ} 50' W.$ , 3.45 chs. dist.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land consists of rolling hills with meadows bordering  
the North Fork of the Humboldt River. The soil is clay  
loam and gravel on the hills, a sandy silt in the river  
bottoms.

Principal use of the township is cattle grazing and  
raising of native hay.

A ranch is located in section 21.

No mineral formations were noted during the course of  
the survey.
