

CHAINS

General Description

The township is located about six (6) miles NE of Deeth, Nevada in the Tabor Flats.

The land is gently rolling, draining southerly through Tabor Creek, which enters the township on the N. bdy., of sec. 3, leaving near the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 on the S. bdy., Bishop Creek enters the township on the E. bdy., of sec. 36, leaving near the cor. of secs. 34 and 35 on the S. bdy.

The soil consists mostly of a clay loam. A large portion of the township has been cleared and reseeded. There is no timber.

A graveled road enters the township on the S. bdy., of sec. 32 leaving near the cor. of secs. 2 and 3 on the N. bdy.

The principal use of the township is for cattle grazing. Some native hay is produced along Tabor and Bishop Creeks.

There are no settlers in the township.
