GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The township is located about 12 miles NE. of Deeth, Nevada. The land is gently rolling, draining southerly by Tabor Creek, which enters on the N. bdy. near the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of sec. 3, leaving on the S. bdy. of sec. 34. Mary's River enters the township on the N. bdy. of sec. 6, leaving near the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of sec. 19 on the W. bdy.

The soil consists mostly of a clay loam. A large portion of the township has been cleared and reseeded. There is no timber. A graveled road enters the township near the cor. of secs. 34 and 35 on the S. bdy., leaving near the cor. of secs. 1 and 2 on the N. bdy.

The principle use of the township is for cattle grazing. Some native hay is produced along Mary's River and Tabor Creek. There are no settlers in the township.
