Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush and creosote bush.

The point for the N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 5 is at midpoint, and on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

From this corner, the standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 32, T. 16 S., R. 50 E., hereinbefore described, bears S. 89° 46' W., 12.71 chs. dist.

The point for the N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 6 is at proportionate distance; and on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

From this corner, the standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 16 S., R. 50 E., hereinbefore described, bears S. 89° 42' W., 14.855 chs. dist.
