

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY, T. 17 N., R. 60 E.

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 4 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, and in a mound of stone to cap, with brass cap mkd.

The cor. of Tps. 18 N., Rs. 60 and 61 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set in the ground, marked and witnessed as described in the 1945-53 resurvey record under Group 278, Nevada, bears S. 89° 59' W., 8.99 chs. dist. The corner was marked incorrectly, therefore I altered the markings on the brass cap to read:

The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 18 N., R. 61 E., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam. set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record, bears N. 89° 59' E., 29.81 chs. dist.

The original cor. of Tps. 17 and 18 N., Rs. 60 and 61 E., monumented with a trachyte stone, firmly set in the ground, marked and witnessed as described in the official record, bears N. 5° 11' E., 18.27 chs. dist. I destroyed all evidence of the original corner.

Land, rolling mountainous.
Soil, sandy and gravelly, stony loam.
Timber, pinon and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush, rabbit brush, and shadscale.

Independent Resurvey of the South Boundary,

Independent Resurvey Superseding the Survey Executed By
E. B. Monroe, Deputy Surveyor, in 1869.

Note:

This line was originally surveyed as a common boundary for Tps. 16 and 17 N., R. 60 E. There appears to be gross irregularities in variance with the record, as a diligent search for each corner, failed to reveal any evidence which could be accepted, as an original corner position, due to the deterioration and disappearance of the original corner monument. Therefore, this boundary is independently resurveyed, and new monuments at 40.00 and 80.00 chain intervals are established for the S. Bdy., T. 17 N., R. 60 E., only, counting from the cor. of Tps. 16 and 17 N., Rs. 60 and 61 E.
