

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY, T. 17 N., R. 60 E.

CHAINS

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 17 N., R. 59 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set in the ground, marked and witnessed as described in the official record, bears N. $0^{\circ} 20'$ E., 38.25 chs. dist.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, sandy and gravelly clay loam.

Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush and shadscale.

Survey of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 17 N., R. 60 E.

Beginning the subdivisional survey at the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., hereinbefore described.

N. $0^{\circ} 01'$ W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over slightly rolling land, through medium heavy undergrowth.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36.

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 29 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
