

## SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 17 N., R. 60 E.

CHAINS

N. 0° 02' W., bet. secs. 3 and 4.

Over nearly level land, through light undergrowth.

Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4.

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

deposit broken glass around the iron post, 10 ins. below the surface of the ground.

Continue over nearly level land, through medium heavy undergrowth.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

The cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 18 N., R. 60 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., marked and witnessed as described in the official record, bears West, 8.99 chs. dist.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 34, T. 18 N., R. 60 E., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., marked and witnessed as described in the official record, bears East, 31.01 chs. dist.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, sandy and gravelly clay loam.

Timber, none; undergrowth, white sage, black sage, rabbit brush, and shadscale.

The point for the N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 3 is at mid-point, and on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
