CHAINS

- 80.70 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S.
- 86.36 Intersect the W. bdy. of sec. 6, T. 17 N., R. 62 E.
- Point for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

The point for the E. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 12 is at mid-point, and on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
