

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 3 S., R. 54 E.

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The township is located in Penoyer Valley, about 70 miles northwest of Alamo, Nevada.

The land is mostly a rich valley, the most northerly portion being in the foothills.

The vegetation consists of greasewood, shadscale, and bunch grass, providing winter range for cattle. There is no timber.

The water supply is provided from wells throughout the valley.

No minerals were noted during the course of the survey.

There are no settlements in the township.
