78.62 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

Land, level.

Soil, sandy loam.

Undergrowth, greasewood and shadscale.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The township is located in Penoyer Valley, about 60 miles northwest of Alamo, Nevada.

The portion of the township resurveyed is mostly rich valley land.

The vegetation consists of greasewood, shadscale and bunchgrass, providing winter range for cattle. There is no timber.

The water supply is from a well located in sec. 29.

There is one family living in the NE. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 20.
