

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE E. BDY., T. 4 S., R 55 E.

CHAINS

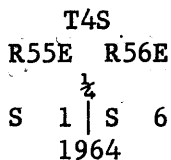
N. 0° 25' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over rolling land; desc. gentle N. slope.

40.25 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with a wooden post, 3x3x18 ins., and plainly mkd.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.



bury the original corner post alongside the iron post.

N. 0° 22' E., beginning new measurement.

25.90 Graded road, bears E. and W.

40.17 The cor. of Tps. 3 and 4 S., Rs. 55 and 56 E., as described in the field notes of T. 3 S., R. 55 E. executed concurrently under this group.

Land, rolling.  
Soil, sandy loam.  
Undergrowth, greasewood and shadscale.

Re-establishment of the survey executed by Reilly and Magee, Deputy Surveyors, in 1881

From the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18 on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

S. 89° 20' W., bet. secs. 12 and 13.

Over rolling land; asc. 90 ft.

6.20 Small ridge, bears N. and S.

24.90 Trail road, bears N. and S.

25.50 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains N.

39.90 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains N.

39.97 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 12 and 13, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
