At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

bury the original cornerstone alongside the iron post.

Land, level.

Soil, sandy loam.

Undergrowth, greasewood and shadscale.

N. 89° 58' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over level land.

34.20 Wash, 10 1ks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NEW.

34.50 Graded road, bears NE. and SW.

The k sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, monumented with a limestone, 6x6x6 ins., plainly mkd. and firmly set.
