

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 3 S., R. 55 E.

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The township is located in Penoyer Valley, about 60 miles northwest of Alamo, Nevada.

The land is a rich valley being developed for agricultural purposes at the time of the survey. Water is supplied by wells located in the southern part of the township.

The vegetation consists of greasewood, shadscale and bunchgrass providing winter range for cattle.

There is a tungsten mill in sec. 36, in operation at the time of survey.

There are occupied houses in secs. 19 and 36.
