GENERAL DESCRIPTION

A considerable variety of land and soil are found in Township 37 North, Range 41 East. The elevation ranges from 4,375 to 8,000 feet above sea level. The northwest half of the township is mountainous, with the exception of rolling land in sections 6 and 7. The southeast portion is nearly level, and the remainder of the township is rolling. The soil varies from sandy loam and alkaline on the desert to sandy clay, gravelly and rocky on the higher elevations. The vegetation consists mostly of sagebrush, shadscale, budsage, greasewood and cheatgrass.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. The Pettit Ranch is located in section 24 and the Frazier Ranch is in section 6. Access into the township is provided by Nevada State Highway No. 18 and desert roads.
